Helmets must be worn by anyone under the age of 18.
Appropriate attire required. No tank tops allowed.
No dogs, alcohol, or unsportsmanlike behavior allowed.
Show committee reserves the right to combine or cancel classes.
Division championships awarded at the conclusion of October 24th Show.
Points awarded per horse and rider combination. Points are pro-rated 6 to 1.
In the event of a tie in English or Western, equitation points will break the tie.
In the event of a tie in Gaming, the most 1st placings will break the tie.
Ribbons awarded 1st thru 6th place.
CC Riders 4-H Club or the Schuylkill County Fair Association is not responsible for injury to horse, rider, or stolen articles.
All protests or discrepancies should be taken to the secretary's stand.
Western and Gaming classes will not begin before 12 noon.
